

Do you wear an above-knee prosthetic socket?

If you are at least 18 years old, this study may be for you!

Study for adults with above-knee amputation

We are looking for adults 18 years or older with transfemoral limb loss to examine how different sockets impact your risk of falling. You do not need to have experienced a fall in the past to participate.

Participants will be asked to:

- Visit out laboratory for 2 sessions
- Complete tests at the lab to look at strength
- Complete tests at the lab to look at balance
- Total time commitment will be 5-6 hours

Participants will receive:

- \$20 per hour for your time plus travel reimbursement

Location

- All sessions will be completed at a laboratory at either Rosalind Franklin University in North Chicago, IL or University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, MI

Are you eligible?

- 18 years or older
- Have an above-knee amputation of one leg
- Have worn a prosthesis for at least 6 months
